This past year, our ministry has once again experienced fruitful growth and expansion throughout the world.

It warms my heart to see more and more of my brother priests taking, in many cases, giant steps of faith towards the renewal of their parishes.

We have learned through our work with parishes that, on average, one missional parish evangelizes 21 people each year. In 2023, our ministry connected with 3,796 priests, an increase of over 1,000 priests from 2022. This translates into approximately 25,000 more missionary disciples throughout the world last year. These numbers reflect a small part of what God is doing through our work at Divine Renovation and what He continues to do through these priests that we work with.

Events last year, such as the first-ever Divine Renovation Open House in South Africa and the first ever Divine Renovation Australasia Conference held in Sydney, Australia represent a portion of that expansion. At these events, priests and lay leaders experienced first hand what life in a missional parish looks like. They are inspired and equipped to now return to their own faith communities and begin the journey towards health and renewal.

You have blessed this work of God with your prayerful and your financial support. I thank you for your generosity, a gift to us but also a gift to all the parishes that we accompany on their journey towards becoming thriving communities of faith. Through your continued support and with the grace of the Holy Spirit, I look forward to another year of our work in bringing parishes to a place of health and on the path of mission.

May the Lord continue to bless our work and each of you with abundance.

It is incredibly hard to capture impact in a report like this. Why do I feel that way? In this impact report, you'll see extraordinary

But for me as President, these incredible numbers across so many countries aren't just numbers: they're people. They're priests I have sat and had coffee with. What would that look like?

In the Jubilee Year 2033, the Church will mark the 2000th anniversary of the Great Commission: to go and make disciples of all nations.

Together with other ministries, apostolates, and co-labourers in the Lord's vinevard, Divine Renovation has discerned a goal that will help us to rally all our energies for the Church's mission:

33k by 33. Our goal is to equip 33,000 parishes to become mission-focused by 2033.

Why 33,000? This number represents approximately 16% of all parishes globally. Models of social change tell us that reaching this 16% tipping point will unleash a wave of transformation in the global Church.

And this is just the beginning. Our vision is not to help 33,000 parishes merely cast off into mission. It is to spark a movement that will ignite motivation in every corner of the world.

This flourishing movement of missional parishes will continue to grow, and our aim is to accelerate and multiply its impact in order to equip 33,000 parishes become missional by 2033.

Every day, more and more parishes around the world are stepping up to embrace mission – and because of them, the Church is nearing the cusp of massive and monumental change.

Notable highlights from 2023



2023 DR Australasia Conference • In February 2023, Divine Renovation hosted the Called to More Conference in Sydney, where over 500 participants from Australia and New Zealand were equipped for the work of mission. Attendees represented nearly all Australian dioceses and included bishops, priests, religious, and lay leaders.



Renewal in South Africa • In October, St. Joseph Parish in Morningside hosted the first DR Open House in South Africa. The event, titled Khaya Lethu ("Our Home" in Zulu), gave attendees the opportunity to experience first-hand what life in a missional parish looks like, the impact the parish can make in the local community, and how renewal is possible for every parish.

Led by Fr. Brett Williams and his team at St. Joseph's, over 130 clergy and lay leaders arrived at a place of hope for their parishes and found the event to be a stepping stone for renewal. Multiplying the fruits of renewal • In 2023, we also saw the sparks of multiplication igniting at the grassroots level.

In Poland, the first cohort of group coaching for Polish priests was established. We saw a similar trend in Lithuania, where priests benefitted from group coaching by on-the-ground leaders eager to bring renewal to more parishes.

In Slovenia, Ireland, and Italy, priests who are leading renewal in their own parishes began gathering their brother priests together to share learnings, challenges, and great things God is doing in their parishes.

We also published the book Wounded Witness: Reclaiming the Church's Unity in a Time of Crisis. Written by Dr. Michel Therrien and endorsed by mission and evangelization leaders, this book contributes a hopeful and much-needed voice to the current Church conversation on the need for greater missionary momentum.















INSPIRE

Divine Renovation inspires priests and lay leaders to move their parishes from maintenance to mission.

Through events, resources, videos, and stories, we're giving priests and lay leaders a platform for sharing inspiring stories of transformation. In turn, more and more parishes are inspired to move into action, embrace mission, and see their parish come experience new life.

Since 2022, the number of priests who have benefitted from Divine Renovation has grown from 2,456 to 3,796.

IMPACT STORY

From drugs to redemption: "I felt like that lost sheep that He goes and looks for."

Mary Our Mother of Mercy Parish is a thriving bilingual parish in Chicago pastored by Father Jose Murcia Abellan, who has been coached by Divine Renovation since 2018. Now leading from a team, Father Jose has never wavered in his focus on the primacy of evangelization: "You cannot be a priest without being a missionary." There are times when you must "leave the 99 sheep and go and look for the lost one." This is the story of Mary Our Mother of Mercy parishioner, Salvador.

In 2021, Salvador returned to Chicago after being kicked out of his Las Vegas home by his girlfriend. Addiction and a life of fast living had brought his world crashing down on him.

As a child, Salvador felt a strong connection to God. He was involved in youth retreats at his parish and felt drawn to the Bible. But as a teen, he'd become afraid to commit fully to following God and to be known as a Christian among his peers at school. "Here in Chicago, growing up was not easy," he said. "It was kind of rough."

By the time he was 17, he was far from the Church and moved to Sin City. He recounts a decade in Las Vegas filled with destruction



where he consumed alcohol and drugs daily Yet even in that season when he ran from the Church, he sees the hand of God. "I felt like th lost sheep that He goes and looks for. He's like 'OK, that's enough. Yeah. Are you coming hom with me?' even though I was not ready."

When he moved back home, his parent encouraged him to attend Alpha at Mary Ou Mother of Mercy, his childhood parish. Th Alpha course reignited his faith.

With the help of Father Jose, Salvado embarked on a journey of healing an redemption. He was able to get help, get sober, and this past year — through the help of Father Jose, the parish, and his family - he married his partner.

CONNECT

Parish renewal is like going where no one has gone to before. But it doesn't have to feel that way.

Catholics want to see their parishes come alive. But getting there isn't quite so easy.

Renewal is difficult work - oftentimes painful. Relationships are challenged. Leaders are vulnerable and exposed. Faith can even be tested.

Renewal can't be done alone. You need the grace of God above all things - and you also need a community around you. This is why Divine Renovation offers a platform that connects leaders to a network where encouragement, new knowledge, and fresh ideas are shared and passed on.

Father Joe is a young parish priest in a noncentral part of England. He first connected with Divine Renovation while an assistant priest in a difficult placement. He even had to pay his own way to get to the DR18 Conference in Halifax.

Now a parish priest, he can apply DR principles in his own parish, The Holy Family - Thanet.

When he first arrived in Thanet, only 50 people were coming to Sunday Mass - with the average age being 70 years old. He felt, "I am not going to sit here and manage decline."

He identified potential leaders, ran Alpha with them and found an immediate response in their journey of evangelization.



He created his leadership team from th group. They spent time visioning, and go excited about reaching out. As Father Joe says "I want as many people to encounter Jesus i the parish...We always waited for people t come to us...how can we go to them?"

Originally from Ghana, Father Joe was used to the parish being a place of community and support for priests. But the culture was different in the UK. Father Joseph struggled with the scourge of loneliness.

DR provided a way to create authentic relationship within a parish centred on a culture of evangelization. DR also connected him with like-minded priests excited to go on mission and he received personal support through his leadership coach.

Amidst grief, this parish has boldly continued forward in evangelizing and impacting their community.

EQUIP

Through accompaniment, we help parishes escape maintenance mode and journey into a place of missional flourishing.

At Easter, four adults were baptized at St. Willibrord Parish in Montreal, Canada. A parish that just a year before was described as "palliative" – being dwindled down to 20 regular parishioners – is now teeming with new life.

Over the last year, St. Willibrord's pastor Fr. Robert Assaly and Fr. Mike Leclerc, (the Pastor of thriving parish St. Ignatius of Loyola), created one of the most innovative, and evangelistic parish initiatives in the Catholic Church – a missionary partnership between their two parishes. The more than two dozen people sent from St. Ignatius were commissioned to join Saint Willibrord as part of their parish vision to send people out to grow the church. With the launch of the mis-

sionary partnership the group from St. Father Mike has taken on the mantle of Ignatius has become regular parishioners at leadership and continues the missionary Saint Willibrord, joining with the faithful partnership with the team at St.Willibrord. remnant that is there. Saint Mother Teresa

Bill and his wife, Cindy, have seven kids and live in Ann Arbor, Michigan, where they are members of Christ the King Catholic Church, a thriving DRaccompanied parish.

Bill grew up Catholic. As a child he had a strong connection with God, but he drifted away as he entered adulthood. Then, when Bill was at college, he met a couple of guys who were on fire for Christ. They told him, "Jesus loves you and has a wonderful plan for your life." Because of them, Bill's relationship with Jesus became central to his life.

Along with starting a successful business and raising his children, Bill has been active in his local parish. One day, he was talking with his pastor, Fr. Ed Fride, who was concerned that Christ the King had become inwardly focused. That conversation began a journey that led Bill and a few others from his parish to attend the DR16 Conference in Halifax.

He remembers the impact of this experience: the hospitality of over 200 Saint Benedict Parish parishioners, the talks and breakouts, as well as the testimony of one woman who had invited hundreds of people to Alpha and the testimonies of those people who in turn had invited their friends and families to Alpha. They spoke about how they had encountered Christ who had transformed their lives. They were so obviously filled with joy and love and peace.

Later, Fr. Ed visited Saint Benedict Parish. When he came back, he said: "There are a lot of people who write books about parish renewal, but there are very few people that actually live it out." Christ the King became one of the early parishes to be coached by DR. Since then, the parish has become missional. After a year, Bill was even invited to coach for DR. Currently, he serves on the board for DR USA.

When asked why he gives to the ministry, he responds, "I don't know how to say this...it really just comes back to the Lord. I just remember having that encounter with Him in a special way as a college student, how much He loved me and gave of himself for me. And then seeing the love of God and His generosity to me repeatedly...I just think this ministry is just such a beautiful extension of that."

Ultimately, he has a passion to support DR because, "I love the local parish... it's where God acts in most people's lives...It's just a real place of grace for people."

He wants to "invest in my own parish, and then as much as I can in other parishes and then in dioceses" and sees DR as an effective way.

Bill hopes "that parishes would become places filled with missionary disciples... people that come to the Lord and then see their lives changed and then go on the adventure of being a disciple."


